EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This is a short summary of deliverable D0.11: the celebration of the final conference of the ITN LINC. The conference took place the 11 and 12 of April, 2015 in the Mercure Hotel Wien City (Vienna, Austria). The conference was co-organized by four senior researchers of LINC partners: Dr. M. Barreiro (Universidad de la República, Uruguay, chair of the Scientific Committee and responsible of the conference program), Dr. H. Dinkstra (Utrecht University, The Netherlands, responsible of the logistics), Dr. E. Hernandez García (Universitat de les Illes Balears, Spain, responsible of the web page) and Dr. C. Masoller (Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya, Spain, responsible of advertising). To give the LINC conference maximum visibility and impact, the location and date were chosen just before the European Geosciences Union General Assembly 2015.

The conference had 36 registered participants from 11 different countries (Brasil, Colombia, Czech Republic, Georgia, Germany, Israel, Russia, Spain, UK, Uruguay, USA). All the 12 recruited ESRs attended the event, but the 3 ERs could not attend (they had finished their two-year contracts and their present responsibilities did not allow them to travel to Vienna). In addition to the 12 ESRs, 6 Invited Speakers (non-members of LINC partners), 9 external participants and one senior scientist from each LINC partner (9 participants) attended the event.

The organization of the Conference (announcement, topics, information on venue, etc.) as well as the registration process was centralized through the web page: <https://finalconference.climatelinc.eu/event/0/>. This web page (linked to the main LINC web page, climatelinc.eu) contains the Program, with links to the presentations kindly provided by several of the invited speakers and contributed speakers.

The invited talks were 50 minutes each while the contributed talks were 30 minutes (senior scientists) or 15 minutes (young researchers). In addition, a poster session was organized (where several ESRs and external participants presented their work), and a social event was organized (the conference dinner, where all participants had the opportunity of exchanging ideas about the work presented as well as future lines of research, in a relaxed environment). The conference web page also includes a section with photos. The logistic and practical aspects of the organization of the conference (registration, audio and video for the conference room, lunches, dinner and coffee breaks, etc.) were in charge of staff of Utrecht University (Ms. Kendra Ng).
